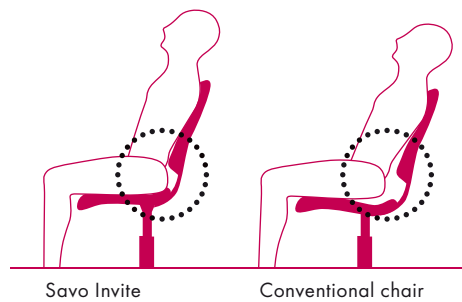
That's how Savo Invite works.





Savo Invite has a unique function that supports the small of your back even when you lean backwards.

When pressure is applied to the backrest, it slides down and along a track. As the point of rotation is at hip height, the movement feels natural and gives the same support no matter how tall you are.

Savo Invite is designed by Jurek Buchacz, the man behind the Savo XO Conference chair which was honoured with the Good Design Award from the Norwegian Design Council in 2007. Yet again, Jurek unites form and function in his own brilliant fashion. The backrest is a superb example, with its unusual shape offering unique lumbar support.

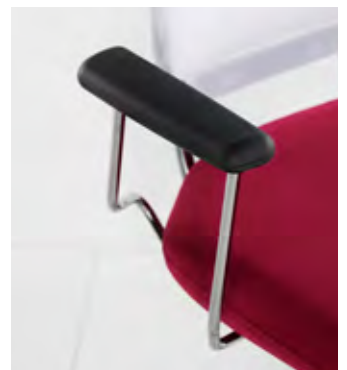



Savo Invite High



Savo Invite is available with a polished or black base on glides, or castors for soft and hard floors. With or without armrests. There's a single lever for height adjustment.

The chair is also available in a higher model, Savo Invite High. It features glides and may be equipped with a footrest.
